

Minutes from Meeting held June 13, 2017

The June meeting of the South Shenango Township Supervisors was held on Tuesday, June 13, 2017 at the South Shenango Township Building, located at 6865 Collins Road, Jamestown, PA 16134. The meeting was called to order at 2:35 pm by Chairperson Livingston. Present were Supervisors Livingston and Slozat & Richter; Roadmaster Joe Biery Solicitor Alan Shaddinger; and Secretary Cathy Amon. Nine visitors were present. Minutes from the May 9, 2017 meeting were approved with a motion by Joe Livingston and a second by Jim Slozat. MC

Joe Livingston moved to accept the Treasurer's Report with a second by Jim Slozat. MC

Visitor's Acknowledged – Donna Brown, 1912 Ottawa Rd., reported that Shenango Lakes had their annual meeting. One of the items discussed was whether the Township was going to tar&chip any of Shenango Lakes Allotment roads. Joe Biery said they were looking into working on the entrance way off of South Lake Rd. Donna also asked about digging ditches. Joe will have Jim look into this. The road crew is still fixing roads from the rain at the end of May. Donna asked Mike Richter about the abandoned camper not being moved. Mike said he would revisit the situation.

Vicki Rothermeyer, 1705 Iroquois Rd., attended to see what progress is being made for the selling/buying of lots in Shenango Lakes Allotment in order to raise money for improvements to the allotment. The Shenango Lakes Seal was sent to Solicitor Alan Shaddinger.

John Novak, Little Fawn Acres. Mr. Novak has a list of questions for the Supervisors.

- Are there any plans to fill pot holes & resurface the roads in the allotment? Joe Biery said there are plans to tar & chip the roads.
- Can the Township cut the low branches over the roadway? Jim Reaugh knows about this. He has cut them in the past.
- Street signs are old and delapidated. Will the Township replace or should the allotment association take care of this? Joe Biery will check, but thinks the Township has signs.
- The question of Association rules versus Township rules. The Township does not enforce the allotment rules. There was a lot of discussion about the mobile home that is placed on an angle. The Association thinks it doesn't meet setbacks and there are no stairs at one of the doors. Mike Richter said he would talk to John Prosek regarding the steps.
- There is a mobile home that a tree fell on and the MH is currently uninhabited due to the tree. Mike said he would look at this after the meeting.

Ann Kikel, 8130 Martin Dr., asked about a camper on the corner of Martin & Lawrence. She is wondering where the owners of camper are disposing of their grey matter? Mike said he would also check into this.

Roadmaster's Report – Joe Biery reported on the following:

- Jim is salt brining the roads
- There were some washouts at the south end of the Township, where the brining would be redone.
- Joe addressed the concern in Little Fawn Acres about a hole in the road. Joe looked at it and confirmed that it keeps reoccurring.

Asst. Roadmaster's Report – Not present.

Attorney's Report – Alan had nothing to report, but would like to have an executive session.

Building Code Official – Not present.

Property Maintenance Code Official – Mike reported that a mobile home behind the Feed Mill is being torn down. There is a property on Rt. 322 that is turning into a junk yard. Mike said he is going to check it out.

Supervisors' Report – Nothing to report.

Secretary's Report – A reminder - Planning Commission public comment period for the zoning ordinance is tonite at 6:30 pm followed by a Planning Commission meeting at 7:30 pm.

Correspondence Received – A Thank You was received from Vangie, Mamie & Chuck Rice passed around to Supervisors.

After reviewing the bill vouchers, Joe Livingston moved to approve the June 2017 bills with a second by Mike Richer. MC

The meeting adjourned at 3:20 pm to go into Executive Session. Executive Session adjourned at 3:45 pm.

There being no further business to conduct, the Supervisors' meeting adjourned at 3:46 pm with a motion by Joe Livingston and a second by Jim Slozat. MC
