Takin' a Chance

I was going to talk about pull tickets this issue, but since quite a few of you had questions about the Monthly Drawing last month, I should probably tackle that

Monthly Drawing

This is the oldest of our games of chance. Members who wish to participate pay \$5 to PRINT their name and local membership number on the numbered monthly sheet. All of that money is tabulated and then deposited into the General Fund. At the end of the month the trustees tally the total monies generated with the monies carried over from the previous drawing(s). Disposition comes in \$5000 increments, with a \$500 guaranteed jackpot for those who attend the drawing. When the pot reaches \$15,500, anything over that amount is distributed in \$500 increments again, to those who attend the drawing.

On the last Saturday of each month at 10 p.m., winners are pulled from a drum containing "chips" with the local numbers of aerie and auxiliary members (M 1501, W 2355, etc.). If a signed-up member's number is pulled and he or she is present, they win a jackpot; if his/her number is pulled and they are absent, they get half of that jackpot. If a number is pulled and the member is not signed up, they get nothing and that jackpot is set aside for next

Dear Sisters,



month's drawing. THAT'S how the pots get built up.

As I said before, once there are three \$5000 jackpots, all excess is distributed that night in \$500 increments to participants who are present. This second drawing is based on the order you signed up, NOT your member number. Multiple sign-ups are permitted, but are only REALLY advisable if there are multiple \$500 jackpots.

The question that came up last month was, "Why isn't there a \$5000 pot?" The aerie can only give out what it collects. If members have hit jackpots in previous months, and there's only \$3500 in the kitty, that's all that can be distributed.

In accordance with Ohio law, 100% of all Monthly Drawing receipts are distributed.
