**RESOLUTION NO. 15-52**

**APPROVING AN AGREEMENT WITH REACH OUT OF MONTGOMERY COUNTY  
FOR THE OPERATION OF A COMMUNITY PARAMEDIC PROGRAM  
IN JEFFERSON TOWNSHIP**

The Board of Trustees of Jefferson Township, Montgomery County, Ohio met in work session session on the 21st day of July 2015, at 7:00 p.m. at the Township Offices located at One Business Park Drive, with the following members present:

Trustee Woods moved for the adoption of the following Resolution:

**WHEREAS**, Reach Out is a charitable, non-profit incorporated entity providing free medical services for low income, indigent individuals and families in Montgomery County; and

**WHEREAS**, Jefferson Township desires to facilitate such medical services for the local community; and

**WHEREAS**, The parties mutually desire to see such services performed in Jefferson Township.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Jefferson Township Trustees approves the attached agreement with Reach Out, which contains the following provisions:

1. The parties hereby agree that a clinic managed and operated by Reach Out, will be established at Jefferson Township Station 59, 7828 Dayton-Liberty Road, Dayton, Ohio, 45417.
2. Reach Out agrees to provide and supply all labor, personnel, equipment, and supplies necessary for clinic operation.
3. Reach Out is at its sole discretion in determining how best to provide such services
4. Notwithstanding the above, the parties agree that Jefferson Township Fire Department employees may act as representatives of Reach Out. This JTFD employee will provide outreach to the local community by providing case management and mobile integrated health care services within the scope of practice of a paramedic as defined by the State of Ohio Division of EMS and the Greater Miami Valley EMS Council protocols. Reach Out will make a onetime payment of \$14,000 to the Township to cover their portion of expenses, including the overall salary of the JTFD employee.


