_____ ***Auditing** – Audit church financial records and prepare yearly report.

_____ **Baptism** – Prepare the baptistry and assist candidates for baptism.

_____ **Audio Team** – Operate sound board in 9:00 or 11:00 worship gathering. Please indicate which service you would like to serve in:

_____ **Projection Team** - Operate video projection system in 9:00 or 11:00 worship. Please indicate which service you would like to serve in:

_____ ***By-laws** – Review the church’s bylaws and present revisions as needed.

_____ **Lord’s Supper** – Prepare the bread and juice prior to worship. Clean and store serving trays afterward.

_____ ***Missions** – Coordinate, promote, and lead the church’s mission activities to share Christ’s love around Wallace and around the world.

_____ ***Nominating** – Enlist and present people for leadership positions to the church.

_____ ***Personnel** – Oversee the policies, job descriptions, and other matters concerning our support staff and ministerial staff.

_____ **Properties** – Oversee maintenance for church building, grounds, and vehicles.

_____ **Social** – Plan, prepare for, and facilitate special dinners and celebrations, including and especially Homecoming

_____ ***Stewardship** – Teach and promote wise, biblical money management among church members, and prepare, promote, and administer the annual budget to assist the church in fulfilling its mission.

_____ **Tellers** – Count, record, and deposit the offering for each week. Tellers work in groups of 2, counting and recording on Mondays around 9:00 a.m.

_____ **Children’s Ministry** – Join the rotation of volunteers who plan and lead our WallaceKids ministry on Sunday mornings from 10:00 to 11:00 for children in preschool through 5th grade.

_____ **Life Café Nursery** – Join the team of childcare volunteers who rotate weeks of service in our Sunday 9:00 a.m. nursery.

_____ **Life Café Greeters** – Join the rotation of volunteers who take turns at the door, greet worshipers entering for worship, and who make newer attenders feel welcome and comfortable *every* week.

_____ **Life Group Teacher/Leader** – Prepare the study, encourage attendance and participation, and lead the Bible study and discussion in a LifeGroup. This may be an on-going group or a short-term study. Most LifeGroups meet Sunday mornings from 10:00am-11:00am, but could meet any day or time during the week that works best for participants.
