INTRODUCTION

The report contains alcohol-related information collected in all twenty-three counties in the State of Wyoming for a period of twelve months (January 1 through December 31, 2011 by the Wyoming Association of Sheriffs and Chiefs of Police. Information was collected from a total of 19,003 persons who were arrested and subsequently detained in a county detention facility. It also includes statistics from persons booked into the Fremont County Alcohol Crisis Center.

This report provides detailed county specific alcohol-related information and is a supplement to the Alcohol and Crime in Wyoming -2011^1 report.
