County League Rep Vic Gurinowitsch reported that the County League meeting minutes are available on the County League website. Mike Sabat reported that doe tags for next year will be going to a computerized system. The Midland Field Day will be held on July 15, 2023.

Mike Sabat reported that Smallbore shooting has started and they are sending their targets in for scoring. Regular shooting days will be on Wednesdays. Anyone wanting to join should contact Mike Sabat or Greg Paff.
