Lakewood Forest Civic Association Meeting Minutes – June 6, 2023

The monthly meeting of the LFCA was called to order at 7:05 pm by president Jodi Cole. Other board members present were Scott Johnson, Jamie MacKeen, Terri Cole, Lori Estepp and Linda Musthaler. Justin Minto attended as a guest.

<u>Minutes</u>

The minutes from the May 2023 meeting were reviewed. Scott J. made a motion to accept the minutes as submitted. Terri C. seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

Treasurer Report

Scott J. provided the monthly financial report for May. As of May 31, 2023, we had \$37,438.77 in total funds. There is \$16,643.95 in the checking account, with two outstanding checks totaling \$5,650. We issued three checks in May totaling \$6,177. The money market account has a balance of \$9,524.93 and the 12-month CD has a value of \$5,619.89.

In comparing the budget to actual expenditures as of end of May, we have a surplus of \$8.

We received no money this month from Graham Management for homeowners' LFCA membership dues. Scott J. will contact Graham about our payments.

Since the last meeting, the board held a vote by email to authorize C&G Tax Service to file our tax return via computer.

LRC Annual Dues

We budgeted \$450 but the dues have gone up to \$485. Jamie M. made a motion that we pay the dues and Scott J. seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.

Projects and Events

Curb Number Painting

The painting for Phase II is halfway done. Lori E. mailed a check for half payment.

Garage Sale

The fall garage sale dates are November 10, 11 and 12, 2023.

Scholarships

Scott J. wrote out 2 checks at this meeting. Linda M. will send them to the students' schools.

4th of July event

Linda M. went over the details for the event. It will be a pool party at the LRC from noon until 3 PM.

National Night Out

Jodi C. contacted Precinct 3 Parks Department about booking the local park pavilion, but no bookings can be made more than 3 months out. A tentative date for the event is September 30, with a backup date of October 7.

Bylaws Update

The board drafted changes 2 years ago but they were never completed because they technically follow the law. Jodi C. will send out the draft to the board members for review and then send it to an attorney. We previously approved up to \$500 for the attorney fee. In the HOA billing package that went out last December, we informed residents that we intend to update the bylaws.

School Clothing Swap

Jamie M. put out a save-the-date notice for early August. The event will probably run from 9 AM to noon.

Other Business

<u>Reimbursements and Checks</u> Linda M. - \$149.18 for 4th of July supplies

Terri C. made a motion to issue reimbursement. Scott J. seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.
