

Rolls and Responsibilities? What? Why?

As the Public Education Chair one of my responsibilities is to answer questions that come into our website. The most frequent question I get is: "We've adopted this dog and we think it's a Podengo." This is a simple question to answer. I ask for pictures. I can honestly say that the majority are a mix of some type of terrier, which is quickly answered by, "He/she is adorable, but I don't think it's a Podengo", but he/she is lucky to have found his/her perfect home. Those that are questionable, of which I have had a chance to lay hands on, are most definitely Podengo Pequenos. Not very well bred, had no microchip, but Podengo never- the-less.

That brings me to the second request I receive. We are looking for a Podengo, "can you help us?" After a few questions back and forth trying to find out exactly what they are looking for and answering any questions, they might have, I try to locate a breeder in their area. Problem is, we have very few breeders on the Preferred Breeders List. Why is this you might ask? Well, the simple answer is, that the membership does not realize they have to submit a request to the board to be placed on the list, and secondly, they have to do the minimum health checks required from the Parent Club. Those health checks include: Hips, Patellas, and Eyes.

Now here are the questions I have for our Membership. Why are YOU, as a breeder, not asking to be placed on our Breeder Referral List? "Secondly why are you not doing the minimum health checks that the Parent Club requires?

Okay, Okay, I've heard all the excuses, "we don't have hip problems." I hate to break this to you, but we do! What about LCP – Legg Calve Perthes? If you do not prelim your hips, how do you know if LCP exists? "hips are not done until the age two and I want to breed my dog before that". Well the fact is, LCP shows up on x-ray at a very young age, as early as 6 months. So why not prelim? And then do the OFA hips at 2 yrs. If we don't x-ray for hip issues and continue to bury our heads in the sand, then when they come to bite us it just might be a little late to worry about.

We know we have luxating patella's. Not severe, yet but they are out there.

Now on to eyes, we all know there are eye issues in this breed. *(should you name the diseases here?)* So why are you not checking eyes every year? Why are you not sending in the results to OFA? The popular response is "it costs too much money." In my opinion, this is just an excuse. Did you know that OFA provides a kennel discount?

If you cannot or will not post testing results to OFA than you are not a serious breeder interested in preserving the health of this wonderful breed for the next generation of Podengo lovers. (*We need to re-word this so that it does not sound like an attack on any individual.*) may I suggest...


By being proactive and having these tests done in advance of breeding your litters you are being a "responsible breeder" and your puppy buyers will be more confident in the health of the puppies you produce. By posting your results to the OFA directory you are telling the other PPPA breeders, your peers, that you are a "responsible breeder" and here is the proof. If you are using another service other than OFA for hip evaluations that is great! Provide the results to our Health Committee for record keeping.

For those of you that DNA your breeding pairs I applaud you! That is a feather in you cap as a "responsible breeder". But DNA does not give us all the answers needed to breed healthy, happy puppies.

The responsibilities of the Public Education Chair are:

- 1. Educate the general public on this wonderful little breed.
- 2. Find a breeder within the Parent Club that is listed on our breeder referral list.

I've tried to do my part; now let's see if you can do your part by first asking to be placed on our breeder referral list and by doing the basic health tests on your breeding dogs that the Parent Club requires.
