Norma Chu has pioneered tirelessly for our community, chairing or serving on many boards, from the earliest days of numerous such boards, in the Chinese American community. The Chinese American Planning Council (CPC), Cosmopolitan Lions Club, Asian Women United, and Pan Pacific Southeastern Asian Women's Association are only a few owing much to Norma's efforts.
