DESCRIPTION: This is a high-end vintage recurve from the early 1960's. I have not be able to identify it. It looks a lot like an early 60's York Super Crest. Given the serial number and construction, I am sure this is a company made bow, not a homemade one. The tips have been reinforced with not only 4-layer overlays, but also a wedge (see last page). This treatment was reserved for only a few high-end bows. I put this reconditioned bow to a stress test (held at full draw for 16 hours) to assure the old glues still held and no stress cracks would develop. Bow has no delamination; no cracks; limbs are straight. Overlays and tips are in great condition. No drilled holes; No chips, dings or cracks. No crazing or stress cracks; A few minor scratches and nicks here and there. Overall, this is a really nice bow in excellent condition for its age. Comes with a new string.

Note: Limbs are white but may look bluish in some pics.
