I have evidence of criminal conduct by Lindsay Animal Shelter. The evidence shows that LAS is selling shelter animals to slaughter. There are two violations of Pen. 597.2 and one violation of Pen. 597X. ( The Appy horse was blind.) There are eyewitnesses who are willing to testify. Please see enclosures, laws.

Dinuba Sales Yard must keep paperwork for two years which provides the final destination and disposition of all the horses they auction. If you care to make that request, I'm sure you will have all the necessary information needed to file charges.

Consignment #64828, No. 2843, M, Arabian, 18 years, \$50., #32, 9-4-98  
#32 is Steve Stone, a well-known killer buyer.

Consignment #63864, No. 9001, Appy horse, \$300., #32, 10-2-98  
#32 is Steve Stone, killer buyer.

Pen. 597.2 states that shelters may NOT sell to killer buyers.

Pen. 597X states that no one may transport for commercial slaughter out of the state any equine that is disabled. This includes blind horses.

I have enclosed some additional pertinent laws.

I am requesting a formal investigation.
