The circus is presented in the school gymnasium. Protective floor mats cover the performance area. NO DAMAGE IS DONE TO THE GYM FLOOR. All equipment is rubber-tipped and floor mats are made of heavy vinyl. The 90-minute circus performance features variety acts including jugglers, trapeze, unicycles, performing dogs, balancers, comedy, novelty and specialty acts. The performance is enhanced with stage/theatrical lighting, music, and special effects. Truly a family entertainment event suitable for all ages. We need access to the facility after dismissal for unloading and set up. The circus performs seven days a week.

The circus provides everything needed: the show, all printing (including tickets, posters, flyers), advance promotional campaign assistance, all advertising, and insurance. HOST HAS NO EXPENSE AND MAKES NO GUARANTEE TO CIRCUS.
