Dear Comrades:

MEMBERSHIP: Dues were invoiced months ago, were due no later than Jan. 1. If paid by Feb. 1, membership reinstatement is automatic but if not paid by Feb. 1, you are placed in a suspended status which (per Bylaws Art. XII, sec. 3) means **YOUR POST PRIVILEGES ARE SUSPENDED ON FEBRUARY 1!** If still unpaid on June 30, you are **DROPPED** from Legion membership (Art. XII, sec. 3) & must **REAPPLY** for membership!

By June 2017, Post 132 had 415 paid members but by Mar. 16, 2018, we only had 373 paid members, & 16 of those are new ones! In other words, only 357 of the 415 of 2017 have renewed!!!! We have potentially lost 58 members (I believe 3 moved on to Post Everlasting)!

PLEASE DO NOT LET YOUR MEMBERSHIP LAPSE! NO ONE IN THE LEGION & AT THE POST WANTS THAT TO HAPPEN! GET YOUR RENEWAL IN TODAY. Come down to the Post and renew; or contact; 1st VC Victor De La Rosa (714/227-5977); Cmdr. Jose Martinez (714/380-2005); Finance Officer, Sid Gauna (714/371-6247); or myself (714/543-9005) and we will process you immediately.

1. Your name, address, phone number and your eligibility.

2. A description of your career objectives. Please include: how you plan to achieve them, what college you would like to attend, community service you have done, what you have already done toward achieving your goal, and your current grade level.

3. A short essay explaining why this scholarship would be beneficial to you.

4. A letter of recommendation from a person other than a member of the applicant's family.

5. Any further information about your accomplishments you wish to tell us about.

Applications to be judged by a panel of three (3) by members of American Legion Auxiliary, Orange Unit 132 or others who are in the education field (teachers for instance) not knowing the applicants. Winner of the Scholarship will be announced at the time of Installation of Officers.
