Directions to Fun Fur Paws (22352 Stargate Place, Mt. Vernon, WA 98274):

From I-5 NORTH or SOUTH:

- Take Exit #218 to Starbird Road.
- Go east on Starbird Rd to the 4-way stop at Bulson Rd
- Turn left onto Bulson Rd
- At the intersection with Tye Rd, turn left to remain on Bulson Rd
- Turn right onto Stargate Place, at the Sign for Fun Fur Paws
- Follow Stargate Place to the arena and parking area

Crating: There will be crating space inside the stall area. You may need to share your stall with others as space is somewhat limited. You may arrive for crating set-up after 4:00 pm Thursday.

Move-ups: The deadline to send in your move-up is Monday, Sept 30, 2019 at 6:00 pm. Move-ups must be submitted in writing (email ok).

Height Cards/Measuring: We will not have a VMO measuring at this trial. All dogs without height cards will still have to be measured by a judge prior to their first run. We will measure dogs from 7:00 am to 7:30 am and various times throughout the day.

Start Time & Running Order: Check in and measuring time will begin at 7:00 am on both days, with first dog on the line at 8:00 am. This will be a 2 ring, 1 judge trial. The class running order will be as follows:

Agility Course Test 2 – ACT2

This is the second level Agility Course Test.

This is a beginning level event designed to introduce and welcome beginning dogs and handlers to AKC agility. The ACT 2 is open to all dogs that have not earned a title in any AKC

Agility class except an ACT1 title. This event has been created to let these dogs and handlers show their beginning agility sequencing and performance skills. In addition to running the courses, exhibitors will learn how to fill out an AKC entry form, what to do at an agility trial and other information they would need when they are ready for a regular trial. There are 2 runs, or rounds.

Any dog that passes both rounds earns an ACT2 title from AKC. Dogs must be 15 months or older to be able to enter. Mixed breeds are welcome to enter.

Course consists of 11 to 13 obstacles. These include an A-Frame, teeter, tire jump, bar jumps, table, weave poles, spread jumps and tunnels. The dog walk is allowed but not mandatory. Jump height divisions are 4, 8, 12, 16, 20, or 24 inches. Dogs may be entered in any one of the heights. A height card is not required. There are no preferred or regular heights. To qualify, entire course must be completed within 70 seconds. There can be no dropped bars or missed contacts. Each obstacle must be completed. No more than 3 wrong courses are allowed.

ACT2 test will be run after our trial has finished on Saturday. Approximate time would be 4pm. Pre-entry is preferred, but some day of test entries will be accepted until 2pm. Day of test entries cost \$5 more than pre-entry. There will be 2 runs. If both are passed, dog will earn the ACT2 title.

From I-5: Take Exit 218, go east onto Starbird Rd. Go east to the 4-way stop at Bulson Rd. Turn left. At the intersection with Tye Rd., turn left to remain on Bulson, turn right onto Stargate Pl at the sign for Fun Fur Paws.
