I. Marriage:

- A. Matt. 19:4-5, 6 – Introduces us to the marriage relationship: “let not man put asunder.”
- B. Rom. 7:1-3 – Designed to be enduring and lasting: “while he liveth.”
- C. Matt. 19:9 – A disregard for the laws of God, do not go unnoticed.
- D. Eccl. 5:2-7; Mal. 2:14-16 – Pay thy vow.

II. Mind:

- A. We live in a society that provides us with “News as it happens.”
- B. Eccl. 12:12 – The Preacher said, of making many books there is no end.
- C. Eph. 3:1-4 – That which we read, and that which we see changes lives as the food we eat affects the body.
- D. Matt. 13:18 – The Lord affirms we can profit from the things we hear.
- E. Mk. 4:23-24; Lk. 8:18 – We are also given warning concerning what we hear, and how we hear.
- F. Our learning must be selective:
