A Note from Rick: A good week for markets at TLA with all things considered. The hay market was very active and prices were higher than they've been the last few weeks. We had a good run of feeders for our April Special and I thought the cattle sold very well. The sun is shining and the grass is growing and even though the temperatures are still a little cool, the market was very active. We had several different groups of holstein steers and heifers (various sizes) that pretty much all sold in the \$80 to \$90 range. Slaughter cows were steady with last week and the better half of cows brought from \$47 to \$55. The market for fat cattle is still very limited. We did have a few holsteins that brought in the high \$70's to low \$80's. Looks to me like it's going to take some time to get things back in sequence for the meat market even after all the plants get back up and running. The whole process from farm to table has been severely disrupted and for the time being this is what we have to deal with. Looking forward to seeing you all at TLA!
