On Thursday December 13, 2018 at approximately 10:45 AM, Wyckoff Police officers were dispatched to Zabriskie Pond on Franklin Avenue for a report of a dog walking on the ice. Responding officers observed that the small dog had fallen through the ice in the middle of the pond. The Wyckoff Fire Department responded to the scene and was able to rescue the dog from the pond. The dog was turned over to TYCO Animal Control and transported to a local animal hospital.

On Thursday December 13, at approximately 1:40 PM, Wyckoff Communications was advised that a Main Street business had received a bomb threat via email. Responding officers evacuated the building and several nearby businesses, and closed off roadways around the area. The Bergen County Sheriff's Office responded with a K9 to check the building for explosives. The search was negative for any explosives. Numerous similar threats were reported throughout the State. The matter was turned over to the Wyckoff Detective Bureau to investigate the origin of the threat.
