Students: Below is a list of 11 questions. Please select only <u>three</u> questions, and on a separate sheet of paper, write or type your answers.

Each answer must be a minimum of 100 words, and no more than 300 words. Please attach your answers and submit with Page 1 of the application. Thank you.

- 1. Describe your best classroom experience while attending FHS...the one that had the most impact on you. Was it the teacher? The class content? Your fellow students? Explain.
- 2. What was the greatest challenge you faced in high school not related to academics and what did you learn from it?
- 3. If you were given one extra hour in the day—with no homework, activities, obligations, etc., what would you do with that hour and why?
- 4. In your opinion, what is the most significant social/cultural issue high school students are dealing with today?
- 5. You are required to spend your first year out of high school in either the past or in the future. What year would you pick and why?
- 6. If you could have dinner with any person (living or dead) who would it be? What would you want to discuss?
- 7. Explain in detail the impact of social media in your high school years and how it has affected you (positively or negatively).
- 8. Describe a friend of yours who is very different from you, and something you have learned from that person.
- 9. Tell us about ONE thing that makes you really happy.
- 10. Describe a misconception that adults have about teenagers.
- 11. Explain how you think social media either does or does not interfere with the classroom experience.
