

The men's prayer breakfast in July was a powerful time in the Lord. Bishop Johnson spoke mightily on God's promise to His people and how believers have to remain connected, know they're connected and in some case, 'test' their connection. This leads to a compelling question...is your connection hot, lukewarm or cold? Is the connection simply following a routine of what one perceives to be holiness but only to find out it's dressed up and superficial? If we recall as kids (or even our own kids), we make promises and the kids will remind you until you deliver. It is a committed word or expectation that must be honored, however there are time that we've fallen short or have been the recipient of someone who didn't deliver on their promise.
