

DEC to Host Virtual Meeting to Approve Rate Decrease For All Members

Delaware Electric Cooperative's Board of Directors will vote on a proposed rate decrease at a special meeting to be held tomorrow, May 20th at 6:30 p.m.

If the rate decrease is approved, electric costs for members would fall by four percent, saving the average Co-op member \$60 per year. The move would save DEC's membership \$7 million per year. The rate decrease would take effect on June 1.

Co-op employees work very hard to keep electric rates affordable. Wholesale power costs are falling, and our Beat the Peak program has also helped to keep our rates among the lowest in the region.

Due to COVID-19 gathering restrictions, the meeting will be held via teleconference.
