One-bite Molasses Brownies

Ingredients:

- 1 cup dark chocolate chips or coarsely chopped bittersweet chocolate
- ½ cup butter, cut into pieces
- 1/4 cup Crosby's Fancy Molasses
- 2 large eggs
- 1 cup sugar
- 1 tsp. vanilla extract
- 1/2 tsp. baking powder
- 2 Tbsp. unsweetened cocoa powder
- 1/4 tsp. salt
- 1 cup flour

Instructions:

1. Heat the oven to 350°F. Line an 8-by-8-inch metal baking pan with parchment paper.
 2. Combine the chocolate and butter in a medium saucepan and cook over low heat, stirring frequently, until melted and smooth.
 3. Remove from the heat, add molasses and let cool slightly, about 5 minutes.
 4. Whisk the eggs, then stir in the sugar, vanilla, baking powder, cocoa and salt. Stir until just incorporated. Add the chocolate mixture and stir until combined. Add the flour and fold in until just incorporated, about 20 strokes (no white streaks should remain).
 5. Pour the batter into the prepared pan (spreading it out and smoothing the top).
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6. Bake 30 minutes (until the center is set). Remove to a wire rack and let the brownies cool for at least 20 minutes.
 7. Cut when cool
