First Reading Sirach 3:2-6, 12-14

1. How am I treating my parents, or grandparents?

Second Reading Colossians 3:12-21

1. I have often felt that the first part of this (until going into the family) would make a wonderful summary of what parishes should be doing. What do you think? Reread this wonderful exhortation of Christian living.

Gospel Luke 2:22-40

- 1. Simeon and especially Anna had waited a long time for the Messiah. Neither one knew when He was going to arrive until He did. Have you ever waited a long time for something that you did not know when it was coming? How did that go?
- 2. All of us are waiting for the second coming of Jesus Christ, or death, whichever comes first. How is this wait going?
