Rowland House (aka The Shovel Shop) — Cheltenham, Pennsylvania



Rowland House, also known as the Shovel Shop, is a historic home located at Cheltenham Township, Montgomery County, Pennsylvania. It was built about 1774, expanded about 1810–1820, with additions built in the early 1900s and 1920s /1930s. The structure is a 3 1/2-story, stuccoed stone building with a steep gable roof and one-story, frame addition. The sign in front says it is the Thomas Rowland & Sons Shovel Works, produced by the Rowland Mill, and founded by Benjamin Rowland (1777-1824) in 1795. This building was added to the National Register of Historic
