Please help us to honor our members. If you know of illnesses or anything that effects our members, please let us know. Thoughts and prayers go out to all in need!

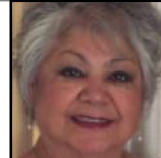

ORANGE POST 132 EMERGENCY OPERATIONS

Have you ever wondered what you could do during a catastrophic emergency that affected your community? There are a number of things; however we will concentrate on those things specific to us as Legionnaires and especially as members of Orange Post 132. First let me explain what will happen during an emergency.

During an emergency of catastrophic proportions such as an earthquake, fire or flood, the first thing that will happen is that all conventional means of communication will be shut off. Whether this is because of a lack of power at the source of the communication or that it is shut down so that they will not interfere with emergency services such as Police and Fire. That means that there will be limited land-line service and probably no cell phone service. Whether this is in our immediate vicinity or in a neighboring vicinity, we as Legionnaires can help if we have the proper resources.

As an example, and for inspiration, how Palm Springs, CA Post 519 came to the aid of their community and the surrounding area after the July 25, 2018 Idyllwild, Calif., fire can be read about here:

A part of Post 519's preparedness is an amateur radio club station. This station is set up in the old sound booth which was used for controlling remote broadcasts during the 40s and 50s by recording artists with names like Bob Hope, Bing Crosby, Jack Benny and Frank Sinatra. Recently, members of the post renovated the studio and turned it into a "ham shack" – the room which holds the amateur radio station equipment. It is from here that communications can be carried out during emergencies assisting Police and Fire organizations.
