Thanks for supporting our Ways & Means Spring Purse Auction fundraiser. We made an amazing grand total of \$801. Proceeds from this sale will be used to help support club operations.

Here are some interesting details. Of the 97 items sold, 68 came from the \$1, \$3 and \$5 flat-rate tables. The sales breakdown was as follows: 29 items sold on the \$1 table (which raised \$29), 30 items sold on the \$3 table (which raised \$89), and 9 items sold on the \$5 table (which raised \$45). In addition, 29 items were sold on the auction tables with winning bids ranging from \$10-\$66. This generated an additional \$638 in sales. The grand total (sum of all flat-rate sales-\$163-plus the auction sales of \$638) came to \$801—which will be very helpful to the club's finances in the upcoming year.

Thank you for your incredible merchandise donations—we were so impressed by the quality of many of the items donated. Unsold items that were not returned to members will be donated by Outreach to a local thrift store to help those in need. Also, we'd like to extend a giant thank you to those of you who purchased items. We are happy you were able to go home with so many great purses and accessories. And a special thank you to the volunteers who staffed and organized our tables and collected the money! Considering we had 41 people registered for the St. Patrick's Day luncheon, we think that raising a grand total of \$801 is truly impressive!


