Frequently Asked Questions

<u>Cancellation Policy:</u> Carolina Dive Centers full cancellation policy is located on our website trip page at <u>www.carolinadivecenter.com</u> If Carolina Dive Center cancels the trip you will be given a full refund. We cannot guarantee the clarity of the water or sea conditions. Our boat captain will always attempt to get you to where you want to go, but the safety of our passengers and the vessel is always the foremost consideration. If it is not possible to get you to the primary site, it is usually possible to get you to an alternate site. In that case you will only be charged for the trip that was actually run, cancellation is not an option.

Up to 14 days prior to departure: Full refund.

Inside 14 days prior to departure: Dive charter is NOT refundable. However, we will attempt to rebook your reservation with another diver. If we are able to rebook your spot on the charter, you will not be charged.

Dive Boat

We will be utilizing the Safari IV. The Safari IV is a 45 foot customized dive boat that is slick enough to get you to dive sites quickly, sturdy enough to offer you stability against the occasionally unpredictable Atlantic, and yet roomy and spacious on board. The boat has a full size head (bathroom), 2 ice coolers for your snacks, and a professional crew. She carries all Coast Guard required equipment including first aid kit and oxygen.

Directions to Marina:

The Safari IV is docked at Crickett Cove Marina in Little River. All divers should meet at the marina the morning of the dive. To get to the marina from the South, take highway 17 North from North Myrtle Beach to Little River: After the Intracoastal Waterway Bridge go 2.2 miles and you will see Eastport Golf Club on your right. Take your next right on Baker Street (if you see Kepley's furniture you've gone too far.) Baker street will take you down to Crickett Cove marina. The boat is up front and easy to find. To get to the marina from the North, enter Little River on 17 south: when you see Kepley's Furniture on your left, take a left on Baker Street. It takes you right down to the marina.

Hotel Accommodations:

There are many hotel options in North Myrtle Beach and Little River that range in both price and luxury. Carolina Dive Center is happy to recommend a variety of hotel options that you can book directly.

Fuel Charges:

We are working with our boat charter company to keep costs as low as possible and at this time have not added any fuel surcharges. The largest expense for a dive charter is fuel. With the current unpredictability of fuel costs a small fuel surcharge may be necessary if prices continue to rise. If needed the fuel surcharge will be collected upon departure.
