## San Gabriel Valley Music Theatre's New *Theater Business Academy* Presents **The Broadway Locker**

Weekend Theatre Program on September 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup>!

**Preparing students for a job in the arts!** The Broadway Locker is a weekend training program geared to high school and college aged students with an interest in a career in the performing arts. The program will inspire and teach students how to take control of their career by providing them with both performance master classes and theater business workshops that they would not normally learn in a high school and even college drama school setting. The goal of The Broadway Locker is to help prepare and guide students towards job opportunities in theatre.

Some of the workshops will include Performance Master Classes, an Auditioning Workshop, Creating Characters and Writing Your Own Material, Producing 101, Using Your Voice to Make a Living / Voice Over Acting and Industry Speaker Panels providing career guidance on how to find job opportunities as a performer. The Speaker Panels will include Producers, Casting Directors and other career influencers. All participants will receive The Broadway Locker Resource Handbook and complimentary tickets for them and a guest to attend our professional concert *Broadway Goes Hollywood* complete with a post-show Q/A. For a description of several of the workshops included in the September Broadway Locker Program, please see below.

- Musical Theatre Master Classes performance based workshops in acting, voice and movement.
- The Broadway Audition Experience How to audition for professional music theatre. Picking out the right song and monologue and insider tips and feedback.
- o Producing 101- where students will learn how to create a budget, identify venues, license show material and develop techniques to cover the costs.
- Finding Your Voice in a Multicultural Society writing, improvisation and character creation workshop teaching students how to discover their own voice and create original material.
- Speaker Panels with Industry Professionals discussing the topic of How to Have a Career as a Performer. Exploring places to find job opportunities and being prepared for submitting for jobs. Focus on SoCal regional theatres, Hollywood, Theme Parks, and Cruise Ships. Led by Casting and Industry Professionals.

The cost of the two-day workshop is only \$75 and if participants enroll by August 31<sup>st</sup> they will receive the discounted price of \$50. The program will take place in the state of the art Gary E Goodson Theatre on the grounds of Gabrielino High School at 1327 South San Gabriel, CA 91776 on September 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup>.
