About Dur Club-s Charities

Veterans of Foreign Wars (VFW): Our April Charity

The Veterans of Foreign Wars of the United States is a nonprofit veterans service organization comprised of eligible veterans and military service members from the active, guard and reserve forces.

Their roots date back to 1899 when veterans of the Spanish-American War (1898) and the Philippine Insurrection (1899-1902) founded local organizations to secure rights and benefits for their service. Many arrived home wounded or sick. There was no medical care or veterans' pension for them, and they were left to care for themselves.

In their misery, some of these veterans banded together and formed organizations that would eventually band together and become known as the Veterans of Foreign Wars of the United States. After chapters were formed in Ohio, Colorado and Pennsylvania, the movement quickly gained momentum. Today, membership stands at more than 1.4 million members of the VFW and its Auxiliary.

Their voice was instrumental in establishing the Veterans Administration, development of the national cemetery system, in the fight for compensation for Vietnam vets exposed to Agent Orange and for veterans diagnosed with Gulf War Syndrome.

Our Briscoe Park show will support VFW's Georgia District 3 (Northeastern Atlanta, Atlanta (Buckhead), Conyers, Decatur, Dunwoody & Sandy Springs, Lawrenceville, North Fulton, Snellville, and Winder). Their members are veterans ranging from World War II to the present conflicts in Afghanistan and Iraq.

The VFW goal for the proceeds from our Briscoe Park car show is to directly help veterans locally. Aid focuses on immediate needs such as assisting wounded veterans and their families back into society, back on their feet after a personal/environmental disaster, and assisting with ongoing combat-related issues outside of Veterans Affairs. All funds will go directly to veterans.
