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AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ARTICLE III - SALARIES OF THE NEWTON CITY CODE OF THE CITY OF NEWTON, JASPER COUNTY, ILLINOIS

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Newton, Illinois, that ARTICLE III – SALARIES SECTION 1-3-1 of the Newton City Code is hereby amended in its entirety to provide as follows:

ARTICLE III - SALARIES

- 1-3-1 <u>SALARIES OF CITY OFFICIALS.</u> Effective **May 1, 2017** the following salaries are hereby established for elected City Officials:
- (A) <u>Mayor.</u> The Mayor shall receive **Twelve Thousand Dollars** (\$12,000.00) per year.
- (B) <u>Alderman.</u> Each Alderman shall receive **Six Thousand Dollars** (\$6,000.00) per year, payable quarterly.
- (C) <u>Clerk.</u> The City Clerk shall be a part-time elected position for which the City Clerk shall receive **Sixteen Thousand Dollars** (\$16,000.00) per year. For said salary, the City Clerk shall work a minimum of **sixteen** (16) hours per week in the City Clerk's office and shall attend the bi-monthly City Council meetings. The City Clerk shall also perform such other duties as the City may request from time to time. Additional compensation for hours worked in excess of **sixteen** (16) hours per week shall be at the City's established rate for part-time employees.
- (D) <u>Treasurer.</u> The City Treasurer shall be an appointed full-time position. The City Treasurer salary will be subject to negotiation and shall be evidenced by separate agreement between the City and the City Treasurer.

Except as amended hereby, the new City Code of Newton, Illinois, shall remain in full force and effect according to its original terms and provisions, as Amended, from time to time.
