Subject: 2021/2022 Dues Notice

In anticipation of the annual membership renewal process, the SCCS Board of Directors made the following decisions that affect 2021/2022 membership:

- A) Approved retaining the **annual dues at \$50** with an **active membership cap of 225** members.
- B) Established an **Application Priority List (APL)** where new applicants will be held in priority order based on the date of application when the active membership level is at 225 members. As openings occur, APL applicants will be added in order of their original application date.
- C) Set July 1 as the start for annual dues renewal notices with the dues payment deadline of September 15.
  - a. **Non-renewing members** are asked to notify the Membership Director of their intention to terminate their membership as soon as possible so that applicants on the APL can be invited, processed, and play in the season opening tournament in October.
  - b. If checks have not been received by September 15, past members will be considered as NOT RENEWING and will be removed from the Active Player Roster.
  - c. **Checks are payable to SC Coastal Seniors** and returned to Mark Shanley, SCCS Membership Director, 107 Nutmeg Way, Summerville, SC 29485.
- D) Monthly Tournament Fees have been increased for the 2021/2022 season to reflect the increased fees being charged by host golf courses. The tournament fee has been standardized at \$50, with the exception of the annual tournament for which special fees apply.
- E) Volunteers are solicited for individuals who would like to be considered to serve on the SCCS Board of Directors.
