ANDY HINDERS CONTACTED CURTIS HAMRICK TWO WEEKS AFTER SAID MEETING AND INFORMED HIM THE DAIRY WOULD PAY UP TO \$69,000.00 TO BLACKCREEK AND LIBERTY TOWNSHIPS FOR ROAD REPAIR IF RON FRAHM WOULD ALLOW THE DAIRY TO CROSS HIS FARM GROUND WITH DRAG LINE FOR PUMPING MANAURE.

MERCER COUNTY DEPUTY WOLFE ATTENDED TOWNSHIP MEETING TO DISCUSS THE PROBLEM WITH SEMI HAULING DAIRY MANAURE ALONG TOWNSHIP ROADS.

MERCER ALSPHALT HAS COMPLETED DURA PATCHING ON TOWNSHIP ROADS.

TRUSTEE CURTIS HAMRICK HAS CONTACTED NEW LOOK EXTERIORS TO REPAIR SPOUTING ON TOWNSHIP STORAGE BUILDING FOR THE ESTIMATED PRICE OF \$394.00.


