Clark County School District High School Honor Band Rehearsal Attendance Policy

Attendance Policy: In accordance with Clark County School District directives, each rehearsal will list a rehearsal start time. <u>Students must be in the room by the listed time, with their instrument(s), music, and all necessary equipment.</u> Students who are late to or absent from any portion of any rehearsal or concert with the honor ensemble guest clinician/conductor will be removed from the ensemble. Students are expected to be on site well in advance of all announced times. Other than EXTREME extenuating circumstances this is a zero tolerance policy. Extreme extenuating circumstances do NOT include any kind of transportation issue, vehicle breakdown issue, weather issue, faulty maps or directions, confusion on start times or rehearsal locations, instrument or equipment issues. Any appeals involving extreme extenuating circumstances must originate with the teacher of record communicating with the event committee chair.

Students who display inappropriate, negative or insubordinate behavior or do not observe the CCSD dress code will not be allowed to participate in any honor ensemble. The Dress Code for this event specifically stipulates: No facial piercings, and no hair colors which distract from the ensemble.

Students removed from participation in Honor Band will lose eligibility for participation in the NMEA All State music groups.

Music Preparation: All students in District Honor Band are expected to have the music prepared in time for the first listed rehearsal. If, in the opinion of one of the Honor Band Committee members, the student is not prepared for the honor band experience, he or she may be moved to the bottom of the section or be removed from the ensemble at the discretion of the honor band committee. As the parent, student, and director, we acknowledge awareness and acceptance of these rules and our willingness to comply with them.
