Low Children's Equitation

NJHSA and PEL recognized-Open to Junior Riders as of December 1st of the current show year who are still eligible for Limit 2'6" Equitation. To be shown over a course of eight (8) fences, with at least one change of direction. Fences 2' for ponies. Fences 2'6" for horses. Riders may not cross enter into Children's Hunter horse or pony, Pony Hunter or any class at the same competition where fences exceed 2'6" for horses and 2' for ponies. Low Adult Medal and LOW Children's Medal may be combined to form 1 NJPHA Medal class with points awarded in the respective heights.

Fences at 2'0" for ponies, 2'6" for horses. Horses to show first.

Low Children's Hunter

NJHSA and PEL recognized- Open to horses & ponies ridden by junior riders as of December 1st of the current show year. Fences 2' for ponies. Fences 2'6" for horses. Riders may not cross enter into Children's Hunter horse or pony, Pony Hunter, or any class at the same competition where the fences exceed 2'6" for horses and 2' for ponies. If there are fewer than three (3) horses & three (3) ponies the class may be combined with Low Adult Amateur Hunter to form a Pre-Children's Low Adult Amateur Hunter class. Horse & Pony points will be counted towards the respective High Score Awards. Horses show first.

Beginner Rider

PEL, NJHSA, NJPHA Recognized-Open to riders of any age who have not shown in a division, at any show, where the fence height specifications are 2' or higher. Riders may not cross enter into any other division or class where fence height specs are 2' or higher, rider will no longer be eligible for Beginner Divisions. This division may be combined with Short Stirrup Equitation, if entries warrant. Riders may cross-enter in Beginner Hunter or Pleasure at the same show. TROTTING ON COURSE NOT TO BE PENALIZED, ALTHOUGH AN UNINTENTIONAL BREAK OF GAIT WILL BE PENALIZED.

Beginner Hunter

PEL, NJHSA, NJPHA Recognized-Open to horses & ponies ridden by riders of ANY age. Fences LESS THAN 2' in height. Section A: Rider may not have shown in a division, at any show, where the fence height specifications are 2' or higher. Section B: Horse or pony not to have shown in a division, at any show, where fence height specifications are 2' or higher doing so will make that rider ineligible for Beginner Sections. Riders may not cross enter into any other division or class at any competition where fences are 2' or higher, doing so will make the rider ineligible for Beginner divisions. This division may be combined with Short Stirrup Hunter, if entries warrant. Riders may cross-enter in Beginner Hunter or Pleasure at the same show. TROTTING ANYWHERE ON COURSE NOT TO BE PENALIZED ALTHOUGH AN UNINTENTIONAL BREAK OF GAIT WILL BE PENALIZED.

Short Stirrup Equitation

PEL, NJHSA, NJPHA Recognized-Open to riders 12 years of age and under as of December 1st of the current show year. Rider not to have shown in any division, at any show, where the fence height specifications are 2' or higher. To be shown over a course less than 2' in height. Riders may not cross enter into any other division or class where the fence heights are 2' or higher, otherwise the rider will

no longer be eligible for Short Stirrup Divisions. Division may be combined with Beginner Hunter if entries warrant with points awarded in the respective section. Riders may not cross enter into other division except Short Stirrup Hunter and Pleasure. Fences at under 2'.

Short Stirrup Hunter

PEL, NJHSA, NJPHA Recognized

Open to horses & ponies ridden by children 12 years of age & under as of December 1st of the current show year. Riders may have never shown in any division, at any show, where the fence height specifications are 2' or higher. To be shown over a course LESS THAN 2' in height. To be judged on manners, performance & suitability. Riders may not cross enter into any other division or class at any competition where fences are 2' or higher, doing so will make the rider ineligible for Short Stirrup divisions. This division may be combined with Beginner Hunter, if entries warrant.

Riders may not cross-enter in any other class or other division except Mini Stirrup Hunter. Crossrails below 18"

Riders may have never shown in any division or class, at any horse show, where cantering is required. Once a rider competes in any class or division other than Mini Stirrup or Walk Trot Equitation or Hunter, they are no longer eligible for Mini Stirrup Divisions. Riders may not cross-enter in any other class or division except Mini Stirrup Equitation. Crossrails below 18"

The class may be split into two (2) separate Sections (horses & ponies) provided there are three (3) in each section. All points to count toward one High Score Award.

Academy Equitation

Open to riders 17 and under who ride in a lesson program and have not shown in a class required to canter. Horses and ponies may use martingales for all classes. - Open schooling breaks are scheduled in the prize list. There is no charge for open schooling.
- The Warm-Up Classes are not judged and will be charged on a per round basis.
- All classes are \$20 unless otherwise noted.
- There is a \$25 grounds fee for those who ship in to the show but do not enter in the show.
- A \$10 fee per exhibitor will be charged to cover office and EMT expenses.
