Cost Friday/Saturday: \$140 for 1 session; or \$250 for 2 sessions **Friday/Saturday auditing:** \$20/person per day

Cost Sunday: \$75 per horse/rider (includes 2 jumping rounds and one group flat class; judge's feedback provided)

Stabling: \$40 per day or \$100/weekend

Cancellation: \$50 non-refundable admin fee.

If cancellation required, rider may substitute another horse or rider to obtain refund (minus \$50 admin fee).



BIOGRAPHY

Missy began her show career in Savannah, Georgia in 1974 at 7 years old. In 1979, she rode ponies with Sue Ashe before graduating to horses and riding with Danny Robertshaw and Ronnie Mutch. In 1984, Missy turned professional and proceeded to train many winners, including the Georgia Hunter Jumper Association Pony Medal Finals and many year-end awards throughout Georgia, Florida, South Carolina and North Carolina.

In the 90's Missy rode jumpers under the guidance of Mr. Morris, garnering ribbons at the Winter Equestrian Festival in Wellington, Florida. This led her to a barn manager role for Olympian Nona Garson in New Jersey. Later Missy worked as head trainer and rider for Roger Young Stables in the mid 90's. In the following decade, Missy relocated to South Carolina to train students who won several State Medal Finals and attended indoor equitation finals. She also has experience as the young horse developer at Reflections Farm in Hollywood, SC. Missy attained her "R" USEF judging card in Hunters and Hunter Seat Equitation and now judges and teaches clinics all over the USA and Canada.
