DESCRIPTION: American Archery was an underrated bow company. They made great looking and performing recurves in the 1960's and 70's. This reconditioned Mark II is an exceptional shooter. Bow has no delamination; no cracks; limbs are straight. Overlays and tips are in great condition. No drilled holes; No chips, dings or cracks. No stress lines or crazing. A few minor scratches and nicks here and there. Decals are in good shape. Overall, this is a really nice bow in excellent condition for its age. Bow has rug string dampeners on the face of the limbs (see pics on p3).

This bow was put to a stress test (held at full draw for 16 hours) to make sure the old glues still held and no stress cracks developed.

Comes with a new rug rest and side plate, and a new string.
