DAY 1. SAT MAY 30 USA - IN AIR

Make your own way to Paris (airfare under own arrangements)

DAY 2. SUN MAY 31 ARR PARIS CDG - BAYEUX

All passengers arrive by 11.00 am PARIS CDG Roissypôle bus station in front of the Hotel Ibis Paris CDG Airport. 10:30 COACH ARRIVES. Long distance coach arrives at PARIS CDG Roissypôle bus station by Hotel Ibis Paris CDG Airport to load luggage. 11:00 PROMPT DEPARTURE. We depart promptly by coach to BAYEUX from PARIS CDG Roissypôle bus station. LATE ARRIVALS. If anyone plans a later flight arrival, EITHER they should arrive a day earlier and stay in the Hotel Ibis Paris CDG Airport at their own expense (and can then take the opportunity to visit Paris), OR they must independently take the fast direct Intercity train from Paris St Lazare station to Bayeux, then taxi to our Bayeux hotel). Afternoon stop and visit the MÉMORIAL MUSEUM CAEN. Welcome 3 Course Dinner in BAYEUX hotel with group alcoholic drinks arrangement.

POST TOUR ITINERARY:

Sunday, June 14, 2020

After breakfast, check out and board motor coach and travel to Ettal. (passengers not extending will make their own way to the airport)

We will enjoy an early lunch (11.30am) and then transfer to Oberammergau. Time permitting an orientation tour with your Tour Manager and then Passengers attending the play will remain behind.

Coach and tour manager will pick up group after passion play(10.30pm) and transfer back to hotel in Garmish-Partenkirchen.

Monday, June 15, 2020

After breakfast depart to Linderhof to visit the castle. It is the smallest of three royal castles and was built by King Ludwig II during the 19th century as a hunting lodge. Built in French Rococo style, the castle has a Moorish pavilion.

After visit we will drive to Wieskirche church for a visit. The pilgrimage **church** has been a UNESCO World Heritage site since 1984. On to Landsberg for a photo stop. Continue to Dachau for a visit to the concentration camp. The Dachau Concentration Camp was the first of its kind opened in Germany by Adolf Hitler's Nazi government in 1933, and it served as a model for later concentration camps. Today, the camp is a memorial to the more than 32,000 people who died and the more than 200,000 who were imprisoned during the Nazi regime. The memorial was established as a site of memory and education in 1965, 20 years after Dachau was liberated by American troops. We then continue to Munich. This evening dinner at Hofbrau house.

Tuesday, June 16, 2020

After breakfast, we start our city tour of Munich. Arrive at Marienplatz square, cultural center of the city, dominated by the gothic New Town Hall housing Munich's world-famous Glockenspiel, which dates back to 1908. This colorful mechanical clock has life-size figures that dance to music with shows several times a day. Driving through the city, you see countless museums, galleries, palaces and impressive historic monuments. This afternoon is free at leisure. Evening transfer from a central pick up and return to hotel.
