IMPORTANT 2015/2016 NCHSRA STATE FINALS INFORMATION



Call-In Information:

- There will be no CALL-INS for State Finals.
- In lieu of a Call-in, EACH member will need to FILL OUT a NCHSRA State Final Entry FORM and MAIL form along with payment for stalls, camping and entry fees. MUST BE POSTMARKED NO LATER THAN May 11, 2016. *** NO EXCEPTIONS
- Members must have competed in each event twice (2 times) during the regular season to enter in the event at State Finals.
- Members must have competed in 50% of the rodeos to be eligible for a state scholarship and equal share of National travel money.

Entry Fees:

- Entry fees for the NC State Finals are the same as regular season for each performance (each "Go"). The State Finals has 3 performances ("GO's")
 - o **Timed Events:** \$30.00 X 3 "go's"= \$90 for each event for weekend
 - o **Rough Stock Events:** \$35.00 X 3 "go's"= \$105 for each event for weekend

Report Cards:

- Public and Private School Members must bring MOST RECENT Report Card
- **Homeschool Members must bring a copy of the required NC DNPE forms** proving the Standardized Test was administered with in the past 12 months.
- ALL MEMBERS must bring a SIGNED CONDUCT FORM
 - o NO EXCEPTIONS will be made for the information listed above & will be needed before checking in.

Dress Code:

- Full Western Attire is requires **one (1) hour** before Rodeo Performance until Rodeo performance is complete while on arena grounds.
- Full western attire is required for the Awards Banquet.
- BACK NUMBERS MUST BE ON AT ALL TIMES.
- Casual dress with back number will be allowed for Saturday Night Social
 - o (NO TANK TOPS Allowed) at Saturday Night Social
- DRESS CODE CONSEQUENCES
 - o 1st offence: You may be fined \$ 20.00
 - o **2nd offence:** May risk disqualification

Student Officers:

- Nominations are due at check-ins.
- Campaign speeches can be given at Contestant meeting on Friday.
- Voting will begin Saturday night at the after-party and voting will close on Sunday, May 29, 2016 at 1:00 p.m.
- Announcement of new officers will be made during the Awards Presentation.

Event Directors:

- All Event Directors Need to be in the arena for assigned events
 - o If a contestant has any problems, they must go to an Event Director which will go to the Arena Director. Do not go to any official or judge.
 - Event directors who fail to be the arena during assigned events WILL BE FINED \$25.00

NATIONAL TEAM:

- If you qualify, and planning to go to Nationals, please come prepared to pay your deposit for camping, iackpot fees and stalls.
- Immediately following the awards banquet, we will fill out National Team Paperwork.
- Member's Parent(s) must be there to sign forms.
- If you qualify for nationals and are **NOT** going, we will roll down to the next contestant, stopping at the 8th place member to make our National Team.
 - o The Next roll down Contestant needs to be prepared to make a decision. Parents/Member will have 15 minutes to decide if you will go to Nationals or not before we roll down to next contestant.
 - ALL DECISIONS ARE FINAL and we will roll down to the next name. (You cannot say "NO" and Change your mind once we have moved to the next roll down contestant....All Decisions are final)
 - *** Please have this discussion with your parents **BEFORE** the Finals if you plan on going to Nationals if you qualify.

MISC FEES:

- STALLS: \$50 per weekend, includes 1 bag of shavings. Must mail reservation in with Entries.
- **RV'S:** \$25 per night for hook-ups, first come-first served.
 - o NO horses in the RV camp area at ANY time.
- CAMPING: Free Dry Camping across the road in field with generators.

PARKING:

- ALL Contestants that are not camping in the RV Park MUST park across the road in the designated area.
- We need to keep the area around the building and lot open for sponsors and special guests.

TICKETS PRICES:

- \$5 per ticket, per performance OR
- \$12.00 for weekend armband pass (Can be pre-ordered on Contestant Entry Form)
 - o Pre-ordered tickets will be picked up at check in
- Kids 9 & under free.
- Contestant and 1 guest are free. (there will be a contestant & 1 Guest arm-band in check in packet)
- Guest of contestant will need to wear there armband to avoid repaying gate fees.

We had 11 regular season rodeos, so we must give away 120 points at state finals. Below is a breakdown. Event winners are determined after average points and prior to awarding bonus points. Bonus points are for All-Around and Rookie only. Only State Finals rein cow points count towards All-Around and Rookie. Shooting points DO NOT count towards All-Around or Rookie.
