

ORDINANCE NO. 12-1068

**AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE VILLAGE FISCAL OFFICER'S RESIDENCE
OUTSIDE OF THE VILLAGE IN THE VILLAGE OF RUSSELLS POINT, OHIO**

WHEREAS, the legislative authority of the Village of Russells Point, Ohio, has previously declared that good cause existed and it was in the best interest of the said Village to eliminate the elected office of village clerk-treasurer; and

WHEREAS, this Council, under the Revised Code, has eliminated the above office and replaced it with an appointed position of village fiscal officer; and

WHEREAS, this Council previously combined all of the duties of the office of the clerk-treasurer into an appointed office of the village fiscal officer; and

WHEREAS, under the Ohio Revised Code, the village fiscal officer need not be an elector of the village or reside in the village at the time of appointment; however, the fiscal officer shall become a resident of the village within six months after the appointment takes effect, unless this council passes an ordinance approving the fiscal officer's residence outside of the village; and

WHEREAS, this council, recognizes the difficulty in employing residents of the village as a fiscal officer hereby declares that good cause exists and it is in the best interest of this Village to permit the fiscal officer's residence to be outside of the village corporation limits; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Russells Point, Logan County, Ohio, that:

SECTION I: The residence of the village fiscal officer shall be permitted to be outside of the village corporation limits.

SECTION II: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this council and that all deliberations of this Council, and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION III: That this ordinance shall, therefore, be in force and take effect upon its passage and signature by the Mayor.
