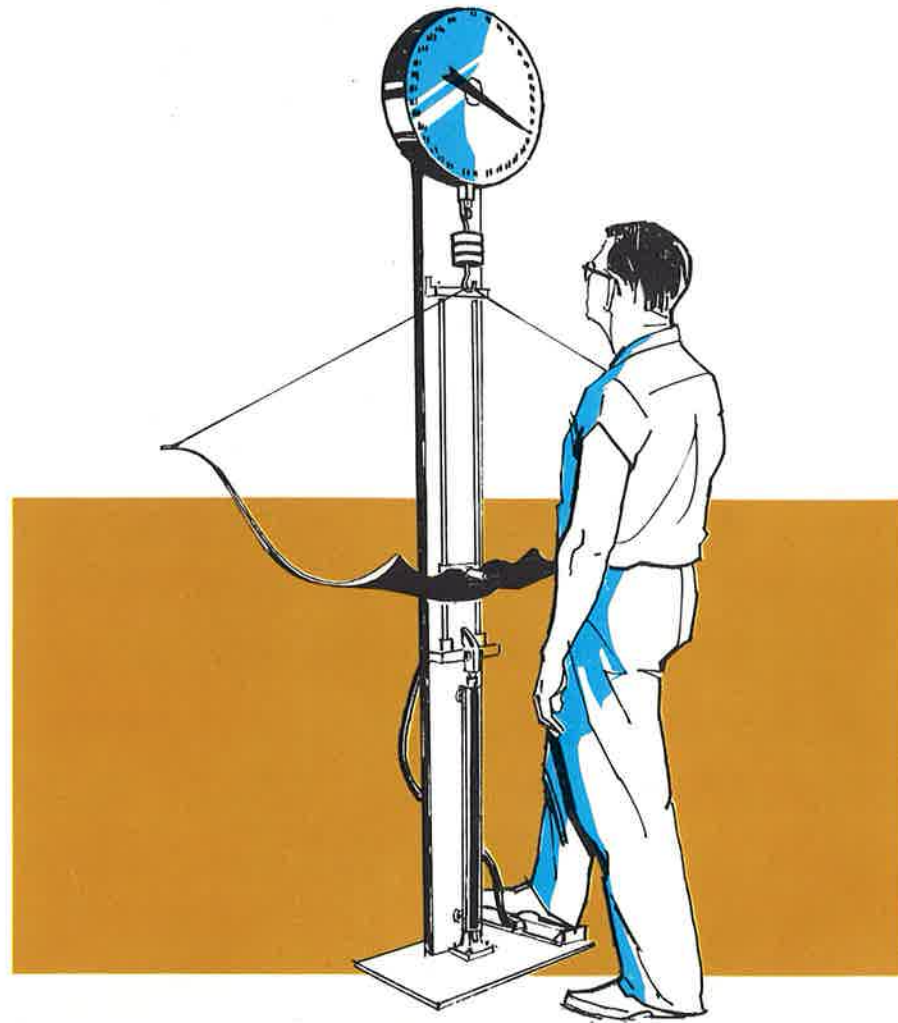

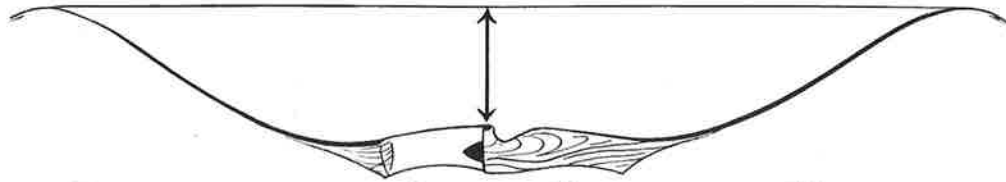

Recommended Brace Height or Fistmele For Golden Sovereign Bows...

All full working recurve bows have a higher fistmele than semi-recurve bows. For Golden Sovereign Bows we recommend from 7" to 7½". This measured from the edge of the arrow shelf nearest the bow string, to the bow string. Some archers like the fistmele at 7", while others like it as high as 7½". Once you have determined your exact brace height, it should be kept at this exact height.
