## September 10, 2017 Twenty-Third Sunday in Ordinary Time Gospel Mt 18:15-20

"If he refuses to listen even to the church, then treat him as you would a Gentile or a tax collector."

Paragraph 1431 of the Catechism of the Catholic Church teachers us that "Interior repentance is a radical reorientation of our whole life, a return, a conversion to God with all our heart, an end of sin, a turning away from evil, with repugnance toward the evil actions we have committed. At the same time it entails the desire and resolution to change one's life, with hope in God's mercy and trust in the help of his grace." Jesus called the people of his day to be aware of the harm they had done to their relationship with God by the harm they do to others by act or omission. Jesus taught us that forgiveness requires an admission of the sin we have committed, a sincere sorrow for that sin, a desire to be forgiven and a determination to sin no more. Jesus also taught us that when someone sins we should help then see their sin. If that fails, have others join us in helping the sinner. Then bring it to the church. If all that fails, they should be made aware that they have separated themselves from the People of God and our Triune God.
