Participants in the CCSWA will be granted access to the **Virginia Ave Recycling Center**. The recycling center is a secure monitored facility and may only be accessed with an active fob during the hours of 7AM to 7PM -7 days a week.

Virginia Ave Recycling Center Rules:

1. NO PLASTIC BAGS! (Including grocery and garbage bags) Paper bags are acceptable
2. Only accepted recyclable materials are permitted - *see list of materials accepted
(The list is rather specific as our contractor does not accept all items with a recycling symbol)
3. NO STYROFOAM!
NO Christmas wrap or paper
NO plastic fruit containers
NO pizza boxes (top of box without any grease is acceptable)
4. Dumping non-recyclable garbage at the recycling location will be cause for dismissal from the program
5. Allowing nonmember access to the recycling center(s) will be cause for dismissal from the program
6. Please do not enter the site without swiping your fob. Tracking participation helps us to know how many bins are needed.
7. Admittance into the recycling center may only take place within the hours of operation, 7 AM to 7 PM 7 days/week. Leaving items outside of the gate will be considered littering -punishable by fob deactivation and possible fines from the city.
8. This program is for residential use only. Businesses wanting to recycle with CCSWA must have approval.
9. If you lose your fob please notify CCSWA so it can be deactivated. Replacement fobs are \$8.00
10. Flatten all boxes! Price is based upon the number of bins not by weight or amount in the bins, wasted space will increase our price.

I have read and understand the CCSWA Recycling Center Rules. I understand that I am responsible for my pass and that any violation of the Recycling Center Rules will result in my dismissal from the program and my recycling fob deactivated without refund.

List of Accepted Items:

- Glass Bottles & Jars (all colors) ---No window glass, sheet glass, or broken glass please
- Metal Cans: Aluminum, steel cans and lids, empty aerosol cans with the lids and tips removed
- Plastic Bottles (empty, crush, and reattach lid): Bottles and jugs that have a small mouth and wider base, such as milk jugs, soda bottles, laundry detergent bottles, water bottles, shampoo bottles, and contact solution bottles
- Plastic tubs: Butter, sour cream, yogurt (Please rinse food out of containers)
- Paper: Newspaper, magazines, cardboard, mixed office paper and envelopes, paperboard (cereal boxes), pizza boxes (free of food debris and grease), telephone books and catalogs NO paper plates
- Shredded paper: Best if contained in a paper bag or box
- Cartons: Liquid and beverage cartons, such as juice, soup, wine, and broth cartons

Recycling Tips:

- Flatten all boxes (empty out any shipping plastic or Styrofoam)
- Mix all accepted items together – no separation required
- Empty contents from all bottles, jugs, and cans
- No need to remove labels
- For plastic bottles: please empty, crush, and reattach lids
- For cartons: please remove plastic caps and straws and rinse if possible
- **NEVER** place medical sharps or needles in the recycling
