In 1911 the Grand Lodge of the Benevolent and Protective Order of Elks adopted June 14th as Flag Day and mandated the observance of the occasion by every Lodge. In 1949 President Harry Truman, himself an Elk, proclaimed thereafter June 14th would be a day of National Observance for the symbol of our Country.


