Those individuals who are attempting to qualify for Loretta Lynn's must purchase a MX Sports qualifying sheet prior to sign-up. *Note: The MX Sports fee is in addition to the practice and racing fees

We will have live timing and scoring provided by LiveView Timing. Mylaps transponders will be used and will be available for rent starting Friday May 17th. Weekend rentals will be \$20 and require a \$100 cash or credit card deposit to insure the return of the rental equipment at the conclusion of the event.

SUNSET RIDGE MX GENERAL INFO:

CAMPING

There is no electric or water hook-ups. Free potable water will be available.

We will park you as you arrive, in the next available space. You may not save spots for people who will arrive later. If you want to camp with someone, please meet off-site and arrive together. **Camping spaces are no wider than 20'**. No campsites, tents or awnings are permitted within 20' of the motocross track fence.

Campfires: Due to the large amount of guests and racing rigs, all campfires MUST be in a contained receptacle. Please **NO OPEN** campfires during this event.

Quiet time is 10:00 pm nightly. All loud generators must be turned off at this time.

Water & Ice: Potable water is available just behind the main concession stand. Ice can be purchased at the main gate.

Showers: Located on East side of concession building. Open during daylight hours only.

Sunset Grille: Full concession serving breakfast – dinner!

Country Store: A must see! Purchase your souvenir t-shirt here or have your picture taken with Indian Joe!

Rider Registration: All Riders must properly register before entering the track. **All riders must personally be present for rider registration. Minors must accompany their parent or guardian to registration.**

No refunds: Once practice has started.

Radio Station: Please keep your radio tuned to 88.9

Pit Crews: Riders are responsible for all pit crew members, family and friends.

Safety First: **Yellow Flag:** No Passing - No Jumping

Red Cross Flag: Injury on Track - Slow Down
 No Passing - No Jumping

Responsibility: Motocross racing, like all motorsports, can be dangerous. When you enter the grounds you assume all risk of injury and/or damage. It is your responsibility to keep yourself **and your children** a safe distance from the racetrack. **Parents, you are responsible for the safety of your children. Be aware of their location at all times.** Never turn your back to oncoming racers. **STAY OFF THE TRACK.** Only registered racers and **authorized personnel** are permitted on the track.

Release of Liability: You are responsible for your own safety. All persons entering the premises must sign the liability release waiver. Parents or legal guardians must sign with children under 18 years of age.

Medical Insurance: We do not have medical insurance for racers, and urge you not to race without it.

Fire Extinguishers: All racing rigs/motor homes/camping vehicles must have fully functioning fire extinguishers readily available in the event of an emergency.

Restricted areas: The woods, adjacent farm land are off-limits! Anyone riding in these areas may be subject to disqualification and removal from the park.

Prohibited: Fireworks, firearms or glass containers.

Tickets: Your arm band is your weekend ticket and must be worn at all times. If you leave the facility, you must have it on in order to re-enter. This is your gate ticket. Do not take it off.

Trash: Please use our trash receptacles. If you need trash bags, you can get them from the gate or Rider Registration.

Pets: All pets must be on a leash. No vicious or unleashed pets permitted.

Access: Gates close daily from midnight to 6:00 am. Please plan accordingly.

First Aid/Sunset Ridge EMS: is located at the Main Gate

Security is headquartered at Gate 1 off 1100 E Street

Lost & Found is located at Rider Registration.

DO NOT take the flags, banners or signage; it is property of the track. Violators will be prosecuted for theft.
