I’ll return to my glory days.

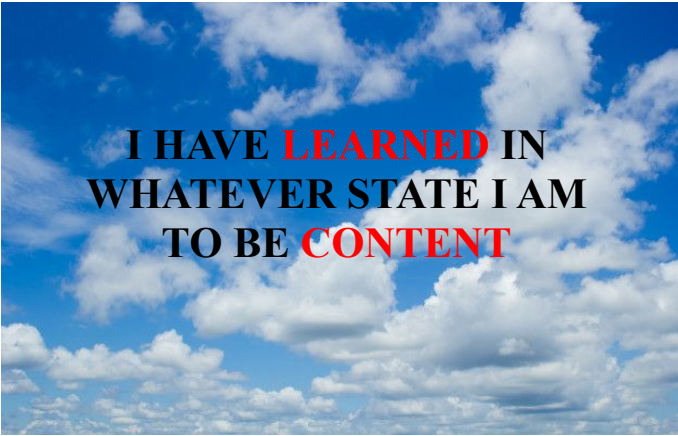
Because Norma lived in the past, her life ended in tragedy.
