

Canada Anemone

This native perennial is great for the woodland border. It makes a wonderful low groundcover that blooms mid spring to early summer and holds its leaf well the rest of the year. Anemone provides nectar for several bee and fly species. It has traditionally been used for medical ailments. That's the good news, now for the rest. Caution should be taken in handling as it is known to cause irritation. This plant can also spread aggressively in the garden so be sure to allow it room to roam.
