

# Flower Show Schedule Award

(GCFP Flower Show Schedule Award)

A certificate is awarded in each category to a member club or group of member clubs, district or council for an outstanding schedule in its category.

Categories:

Small Standard Flower Show Schedule

Standard Flower Show Schedule

Advanced Standard Flower Show Schedule

Schedule shall be for a flower show held during the calendar year (January 1 through December 31).

Winning schedule must score 95 or more. The judging committee at the state level shall have three or more accredited Flower Show Judges.

## Flower Show Schedule Award

May be awarded for an outstanding schedule of a regular or small standard flower show in the following categories:

- A. Clubs under 21 members
- B. Clubs 21 to 49 members
- C. Clubs 50 to 99 members
- D. Clubs 100 to 150 members
- E. Clubs 151 or more
- F. Two or more clubs
- G. Placement Show
- H. Home and Garden Show
- I. Holiday Show
- J. District Show

Two application forms to apply for this award will be sent to the club from the Federation Office prior to the show. The schedule will be judged by the scale of points listed below. The scale of points for a small standard flower show will be the same except that the Educational Section may be eliminated giving an additional 10 points to the Horticulture Section and 10 points to the Design Section.
