



Psalm 91 Plus

Our Father in heaven, hallowed be Your name. Your kingdom come. Your will be done on earth as it is in heaven. (Matt. 6:9-10) As an ambassador of Christ (2 Cor. 5:20), abiding in Christ (John 15:4-5, John 6:56) and one with Him (John 17:22), we come into agreement with our Father in heaven (Matt. 6:9), the Spirit of Truth (John 14:17) and the Word of Life (1 John 1:1). In Him who is true (1 John 5:20), Jesus Christ, we give thanks to the Lord, the living God, the true God, the everlasting King (Jer. 10:10), our righteous Father (John 17:25), for you and your family, for the saints, for the leaders that God has raised up on your behalf and for all men (1 Tim. 2:1-2). As a vessel of mercy, so that Christ might make known to you the riches of His glory, we go up into the gaps to stand in battle on the day of the Lord, to build a wall for you and your house (Ezek. 13:5); for all the brethren, all those called by the name of the Lord; for the leaders of this nation, and all the leaders throughout the world, all those that influence the well-being of God's people; all the people of this nation, and all men, so that you and your family may lead a quiet and peaceable life in all godliness and reverence. (1 Tim. 2:1-2) In the name of Jesus Christ, we proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord, and the day of vengeance of our God (Is. 61:2). We stand, and rejoice in the hope of the glory of God! (Rom. 5:2) It is written (Matt. 4:4), the things that we speak (Jer. 1:7) and pray for you and your family (James 5:16), for these words are true and faithful (Rev. 21:5), and they are the true sayings of God (Rev. 19:9). The word of God is true (John 3:33), pure (Prov. 30:5, Ps. 119:140), proven (Ps. 18:30), , and eternal, for heaven and earth will pass away, but God's word will by no means pass away (Matt. 24:35); it is living, and powerful (Heb. 4:12); it searches the hearts of man (Rev. 2:23), like a two edged sword, piercing even to the division of soul and spirit, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart (Heb. 4:12), and nothing is hidden from His sight (Heb. 4:13), the Mighty One (Ps. 45:3), the Ancient of Days (Dan. 7:9), the Holy one of Israel (Is. 5:24). The words that Christ, through us, speaks to you and your family are spirit, and they are life. (John 6:63) Thanks be to God, who gives you the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ. (1 Cor. 15:57)

In the name of Jesus Christ (John 16:23), abiding in Him, and born of Him (1 John 2:29), we come boldly to the throne of grace and obtain mercy and find

grace (Heb. 4:16) for you and your entire house, all of your people, on every side, all of your family, all of your blood from the beginning of time until the end of time, all those by adoption, and all those by marriage, all your natural seed and all of your spiritual seed. In Christ we come into agreement with our Father in heaven (Matt. 6:9), the Spirit of Truth (John 14:17) and the Word of Life (1 John 1:1). It is written (Matt. 4:4), the things that we speak (Jer. 1:7) and pray for you and your family (James 5:16), for these words are true and faithful (Rev. 21:5), and they are the true sayings of God (Rev. 19:9). To you and your family, to all those who are sanctified in Christ Jesus, called to be saints, with all who in every place call on the name of Jesus Christ our Lord: Grace to you and peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ. (1 Cor. 1:2-3) Evening and morning and at noon we will pray, and cry aloud, and He (Ps. 55:17), the God of all grace (1 Pet. 5:10), shall hear our voice (Ps. 55:17). In the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth (John 16:23), by the precious blood of Christ, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot (1 Pet. 1:19), as an ambassador of Christ (2 Cor. 5:20), abiding in Christ, and one with Him (John 17:22), we ask the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ (Rom. 15:6) to grant to you and your family that you dwell in the secret place of the Most High. You and your house shall abide under the shadow of the Almighty. (Ps. 91:1) The Lord is your rock and your fortress and your deliverer; your God, your strength, in whom you shall trust; your shield and the horn of your salvation, your stronghold. In Christ, we pray you and your people will call upon the Lord, who is worthy to be praised; so shall you and your house be saved from your enemies. (Ps. 18:2-3) The Lord is your refuge and your fortress; your God, in Him may you and yours trust. Surely, He shall deliver you and your people from the snare of the fowler and from the perilous pestilence. God, who keeps His covenant and mercy with those who love Him (Dan. 9:4), shall cover you and your family with His feathers, and under His wings you and your people, shall take refuge. His truth shall be your shield and buckler. You and your family shall not be afraid of the terror by night, nor of the arrow that flies by day, nor of the pestilence that walks in darkness, nor of the destruction that lays waste at noonday. A thousand may fall at your side, and ten thousand at your right hand; but it shall not come near you and your house. Only with your eyes shall you look and see the reward of the wicked. (Ps. 91:2-8) Nothing wicked shall cling to you and your family. A perverse heart shall depart from you and your people; you will not know wickedness. (Ps. 101:4) May the God of righteousness (Ps. 4:1) help you and your

family to be well versed and wise in what is good and innocent and guileless of evil. (Rom. 16:19) The Most High shall be your dwelling place. (Ps. 91:9) In the name of ***Jesus Christ*** of Nazareth, whom was crucified, whom God raised from the dead, by Him (Acts 4:10) you and your family shall be planted in the house of the Lord and you shall flourish in the courts of our God. (Ps. 92:13) In ***Christ***, we pray that you and your people may dwell in the house of the Lord all the days of your lives. (Ps. 27:4) No evil shall befall you and your family, nor shall any plague come near your dwelling. (Ps. 91:10) Thanks be to God who has given His angels charge over you and your family, to keep you in all of your ways. In their hands they shall bear you up lest you dash your foot against a stone. (Ps. 91:11-16) You and your people shall not stumble (2 Pet. 1:10) for God, your refuge and strength (Ps. 46:1), is a strong tower from your enemies (Ps. 61:3). In the name of ***Jesus Christ***, who sits at the right hand of Power (Mark 14:62), you and your family shall tread upon the lion and the cobra, the young lion and the serpent you shall trample underfoot. Let you and your house set your love upon God and He will deliver you and your people and set you on high. In ***Christ***, we pray you will know His name and call upon the Lord, and He will be with you and yours in a time of trouble. God, our faithful God (Deut. 7:9), will deliver you and your family and honor you, with long life He shall satisfy you, and show you and your people His salvation. (Ps. 91:11-16) You, O Lord, shall endure forever, and the remembrance of Your name to all generations. May the Lord God arise and have mercy on you and your family. For the time to favor you has come. (Ps. 102:12-13) The children of His servants (you and your family) will continue and your descendants will be established before Him. (Ps. 102:28) According to His word may the Lord let it be to you and your family (Luke 1:38) for a thousand generations (1 Chr. 16:14-15). When the Son of Man comes in His glory, and all the holy angels with Him (Matt. 25: 31), we will see the Son of Man coming on the clouds of heaven with power and great glory (Matt. 24:30), then He will sit on the throne of His glory (Matt. 25:31). Glory to God in the highest, and on earth peace, good will toward men! (Luke 2:14) Blessed is the King who comes in the name of the Lord! Peace in heaven and glory in the highest! (Luke 19:38)

As a fellow worker for the Truth (3 John 1:8), abiding in the Son and the Father (John 2:24), and one with Them (John 17:22), in truth (John 17:19) we sanctify (1 John 17:17,19, Heb. 13:12) you and your family, your time and your space, by the blood of

the lamb (Rev. 7:14, 12:11). Our Lord and Savior (2 Pet. 1:11), *Jesus Christ*, to Him was given dominion and glory and a kingdom, that all peoples, nations, and languages should serve Him. His dominion is an everlasting dominion, which shall not pass away, and His kingdom the one which shall not be destroyed. The earth is the Lords, and all its fullness, the world and those who dwell therein. (Ps. 24:1) The heavens are His, the earth also is His; the world and all its fullness, He has founded it. The north and the south, the east and the west, He has created it. For by Him all things were created that are in heaven and that are on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or principalities or powers. All things were created through Him and for Him. (Col. 1:16) You are worthy, O Lord, to receive glory and honor and power; for You created all things, and by Your will they exist and were created. (Rev. 4:11) As a fellow worker in *Christ*, a fellow-worker of God (1 Cor. 3:9), abiding in Him, and born of Him (1 John 2:29), and His love being perfected in us (1 John 4:12), we proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord, and the day of vengeance of our God. As a vessel of mercy, so that *Christ* might make known to you the riches of His glory, we claim you and all the people of the earth as the inheritance (Eph. 1:18) of our Lord *Jesus Christ*. By the Ancient of Days, judgment was made in favor of the saints of the Most High, and the time has come for the saints to possess the kingdom. (Dan. 7:22) Awake, you who sleep, arise from the dead, and *Christ* will give you light; awake to righteousness, and do not sin. And do this, knowing the time, that now it is high time to awake out of sleep; for now our salvation is near. (Rom. 13:11) Come near, you nations, to hear; and heed, you people! Let the earth hear, and all that is in it, the world and all things that come forth from it. (Is. 34:1)

Concerning the things we pray for you and your house, in *Christ* we come into agreement with you (Matt. 18:19), and our Father in heaven (Matt. 6:9), the Spirit of Truth (John 14:17) and the Word of Life (1 John 1:1), being of one accord in prayer (Acts 1:14). With confidence (1 John 5:14), we ask our Father in heaven in the name of our Lord *Jesus Christ* (John 16:23), the great High Priest (Heb. 10:21), believing that you and your descendants receive all we ask for you (Mark 11:24), knowing that it is the will of God and He hears us (1 John 5:14). As an ambassador of *Christ* (2 Cor. 5:20), abiding in *Christ* (John 15:4-5), we petition (1 John 5:16) fervently (James 5:16) the Lord to let it be to you and your descendants according to His word (Luke 1:38), and what we have asked shall be given to you and your

house (Luke 11:9). The counsel of the Lord stands forever, the plans of His heart to all generations. (Ps. 33:11) God is watching over His word to perform it (Jer. 1:12); it shall not return to Him void; but it shall accomplish His purpose and succeed in the thing for which He sent it. (Is. 55:11). "My covenant I will not break, nor alter the word that has gone out of My lips." Says the Lord God Almighty (Ps 89:34) We give thanks to You, O God, we give thanks! For Your wondrous works declare that Your name is near (Ps. 5:1) In Jesus' name (John 16:23) so be it. For Yours, O Lord, is the glory and the power and the kingdom forever. (Matt. 6:13) Amen
