

New Vienna City Council Meeting
May 1, 2018

Mayor Pat Hermsen opened the special meeting at 5:40pm. Present were council members: Roger Langel, Jim Naber, and Mike Leuchs. Absent- T.J. Kloser

Naber made the motion to approve the agenda for May 1, 2018 seconded by Leuchs.

Leuchs made the motion to approve the consent agenda, second by Langel.

Fire Station updates, the Mayor stated we are still moving forward with this and trying to get our options laid in place to proceed with this project. Roger Langel will talk to J & L Lumber on the design questions that were presented by council.

Fehr Graham did some surveying at water plant this past week. Mike stated that we have an issue with a hydrant and valve by the ball park and we will have Krapfl come in to repair at an estimate of \$5000.00. The storm sewer at Hoeger park needs to be addressed as the dirt around this is washing out. Mike had Krapfl Const. look at also and they will be fixing at an estimate of \$1100.00. 6-inch rock will be placed around the storm sewer.

The budget will need to be amended due to the bathroom remodel at the park, as the City did not anticipate and budget for this expense. Motion from Langel to set the public hearing for May 22, 2018 at 5:30 pm. for the public hearing on the budget amendment, second by Naber. Ayes-all.

The Mayor presented the bid for the parking lanes from Hwy 136 to the bridge west of town from River City Paving at \$26,599.00. The street will be getting redone and the city will be looking at the parking lanes at the same time. Motion from Naber to accept bid and to move forward, second by Leuchs. Ayes-all.

Resolution #2018-08 A RESOLUTION REGARDING NEW VIENNA CITY PARK AND AGREEMENT TO REVISE PROPOSED CITY PARK LANDSCAPE PLAN was approved on a motion from Naber, second by Langel. Ayes-all.

Motion from Leuchs, second by Langel to sign and approve the work order from DOT on the application to preform work in the state highway right of way.
Mike Neuhaus stated that the streets will be swept next week.

Discussion on the property maintenance ordinance that the City is looking at adopting, we will have the first reading at our next meeting.
