SAINT PAUL CATHOLIC CENTER STORAGE BUILDING UPDATE

Last year the diocese approved the construction of a 30' x 50' (1,500 sq ft) steel storage building to replace two of three, steel shipping containers currently used by the Thrift Store for storage and other related use. However, inventory has outpaced storage capacity. Furthermore, there is no current provision for protecting our volunteer workers from adverse weather, heat and the cold. The new building will add an additional 850 square feet of storage and a work area. The construction will be located on the vacant lot north of E 220 W and ten feet east of the property line in back of the current occupied church lot (*see diagram below*).

The City Building and Zoning Department just recently approved our request to rezone the back lot, and has forwarded the request to the City Council for final approval.

Once the City Council approves our request, we will submit for the building permit and proceed.
