It's election time for the board of directors. We have a great group now, but we are always looking for fresh skills and ideas. The club championship is here! Once again we are including lunch both days, so stick around! There are many competitions happening at once, so pay attention:

- The four net flights will compete Saturday and Sunday, September 8-9. This
 determines the Four Net Flight Champions. One or two of these flight
 winners will be eligible to represent us in the SCGA Tournaments of Club
 Champions Net Division.
- Our Club Champion contest starts on Friday, with three rounds of gross scores leading to the title. Club Champion candidates are competing both in their flights AND the low gross club championship. If you want to compete for club champion, you need to register separately for the extra round on Friday, and play blue tees all three days. If eligible, our winner will represent us in the SCGA Tournament of Club Champions Men's Championship Division.
- We also offer the opportunity for a low gross senior to represent us in the Senior Men's Championship Division. To qualify for this, you must be 55+ and have an index of 9.4 or less. If you want to compete for this, you also need to register separately for the extra round on Friday and play blue tees all three days.

It's time for our end of the year gathering. After the Sunday round of the Club Championship, grab your lunch (included) and hang around until everyone finishes. The afternoon will include our annual business meeting, announcement of election results, recognition of our club championship winners, big news about the 2024 Getaway, and of course our infamous prize-packed raffle. We should have close to \$2,000 worth of prizes to give away, and if you want to help out with donating a raffle prize, please contact Scott or Doug.

Tournament News

The August 2023 Pinehust tournament had 98 golfers/49 teams. This month our number of players was lower than the usual turnouts and hopefully not because of the format, which is always fun and different. Our total purse was \$4094, paid out to 70 players. Our 50/50 drawing winners were: Joe Hederman, Marc Springer, and Justin Hall - each receiving \$105 in pot money. Congratulations to the winners, and thanks to all for making another memorable event.

Next month is the Club Championship! Please read carefully, September 8th through the 10th is for those members wishing to compete in the Low Gross and Senior Low Gross, and September 9th and 10th will be our Net Flights competition. In addition to our tournament, 2-4 players may be eligible to represent us in some of the SCGA Tournaments of Club Champions (TOCC) this fall. (See President's message)

Net Flights – 4 flights playing Saturday and Sunday only. The flight winner with the lowest net score may play in the Net TOCC.

Club Champion – Low gross score playing Friday, Saturday, and Sunday; blue tees only. May play in the Champ TOCC if index is 5.4 or less, otherwise may play in the Net TOCC.

Senior Club Champion – Low gross score playing Friday, Saturday, and Sunday; blue tees only; age 55 & above, index 9.4 or less. May play in the Senior TOCC.

To be eligible for our Club Championship, you must be an active member as of June 30th, played in 3 tournaments and/or 9 skins games, or be a former club champion from the last 5 years.

The entry fee is \$170, which includes Saturday and Sunday golf, lunch, skins and closest to pins. Those playing Friday in the gross divisions will pay for that separately.

After golf on Sunday, we will have our annual meeting, including a raffle with thousands of dollars' worth of merchandise. Don't forget, all the 50/50 tickets for the year that were sold before tournaments will be in the barrel, so you still have a chance to win! We will also sell extra

raffle tickets that day to increase your chances of winning. Even if you don't play in the tournament, please come out for the meeting and raffle!

Club Championship signups will be opening soon so look for the usual Golf Genius tournament signup email and signup early to guarantee a spot. Everyone playing needs to sign up online for Saturday and Sunday. If you are competing in the gross Club Championship or senior low gross, you will also need to sign up with Doug to play on Friday. We will confirm the roster of players in email on Wednesday before the tournament, and release tee times and pairings Thursday September 8th for those playing Friday (Low Gross competitors), and release pairings and tee times Friday September 9th for all Net Flight competitors. After 1st rounds are completed, pairings and tee times will be adjusted for final round of play.

When Signups open, please follow these steps to register:

Step 1: You will need to navigate through the signup confirmation buttons by checking **Playing** or **Not Playing**.

Step 2: If you choose - you can also **SEND** message to the manager with any special request. Please note that pairings for the final round of play will be determined by the tournament committee.

Step 3: Hit the SEND button.

The tee sheet link in Golf Genius will populate names for the confirmed list of players. As always, be assured we will monitor signups closely and communicate with you if there are any issues. Registered players should get a Golf Genius automated signup confirmation email.

For new members, this is a 5 hole horse race in the afternoon on the Tuesday after the monthly tournament. It is alternate shot with a blind draw partner, focused on fun. It's a great opportunity to play with somebody new, from places you may have never played from.

We play the holes as a group, so if you've never seen 20 carts on the fairway at the same time, you won't want to miss it. And when we reach the green, we put out closest to farthest. The highest scores on each hole earn the team an early exit, with ties broken by a chip-off. It's only a \$5 buy in, and the club sweetens the pot with an extra \$100.
